Specially-designed 779cc engine

An engine combines cylinder bodies, crankshaft, top end and forged pistons with a displacement of 779cc - to craft the perfect power curve and character for this category.



Instant torque meets slingshot horsepower

The FZ8 engine is designed for instant drive down low with a thick torque band - making it a lively machine even on shorter trips. But rev it towards the red line, and you'll discover that trademark Yamaha rush of top-end power when it's time to unleash serious sports performance.



Aluminium frame

The black, powder-coated Deltabox frame at the structural centre of the Fazer8 uses a low weight, high rigidity design - giving you outstanding high-speed stability and cornering confidence.
