Featuring a steel tube, diamond-shaped frame, this off-road version of Yamaha's XT660R is built for toughness. Complete with long-travel telescopic front forks, monocross rear suspension and knobby tyres, this all-rounder lets you pit yourself against the most inhospitable terrain.
