Parties involved in YZ125 bLU cRU Cup 2018 edition

- a) Yamaha Motor Europe N.V., (hereinafter referred to as YME), including its European distributors;
- b) Youthstream Group, Lda. (hereinafter referred to as Youthstream);
- c) Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme / Fédération Iternationale de Motocyclisme – Europe (hereinafter referred to as FIM/FIM Europe).

1. Involvement of parties

- a) YME sets the structure and rules for the YZ125 bLU cRU Cup (hereinafter referred to as "Cup"), is the entity responsible for managing the marketing and promotional rights of the Cup and is the entity in charge of the interaction between the stakeholders involved in this project;
- b) The national distributors of YME are in charge of local communication and direct contact with the riders, providing them with the bLU cRU welcome pack and sticker kit on behalf of YME;
- c) Youthstream is the entity which manages the television rights for the Cup and is also in charge of organizing the Cup Superfinale which will happen on 30 September 2018 at Imola, Italy and will be part of the last round of the MXGP Championship. Youthstream is the stakeholder which establishes direct contact with FIM/FIM EUROPE regarding the Superfinale.
- d) The Superfinale event is under FIM/FIM EUROPE European Sportive and Technical regulations. As a result all participating riders must have either a continental annual or one-event license. These can be sourced at the FIM extranet.

2. Structure of the Cup

a) Subscriptions

Subscription for participation in the Cup is possible from 2nd November 2017 until 28th February 2018;

b) National Championships

This Cup will be an integrated part of the national championships, in which the Yamaha riders will have their own ranking, which will be locked by 10 September 2018 for the selection of riders joining the Superfinale;

c) Superfinale in Imola (Italy)

The best riders of each national championship will race in a Superfinale which will happen on 30 September 2018 at Imola, Italy and will be part of the last round of the MXGP Championship;

d) Superfinale Podium ceremony

The first 3 riders in the overall standing will be rewarded with the following prizes:

- 1° Cup/Plate/FIM-Europe Medal + 3 pass paddock MotoGP *
- 2° Cup/Plate/FIM-Europe Medal + 3 pass paddock WorldSBK *
- 3° Cup/Plate/FIM-Europe Medal + 3 pass paddock MXGP *
- *valid for the 2019 racing season, Travel/Accommodation expenses are at the riders responsibility;

A YME Distributor Award will be given based on the national Distributor showing the most proactivity in terms of: contact, registrations, sportive info, media info and presence on the field;

A Youngest Rider award will be given to the youngest rider on the Superfinale starting grid.

e) bLU cRU Masterclass

The top three riders, plus two wild cards chosen by the YME Racing committee and *bLU cRU* ambassador jury, from the Superfinale at the last MXGP Championship round in Imola (Italy), will then participate in an YME managed Masterclass with experienced *bLU cRU* Racing ambassadors;

f) EMX 125 2019 ride

The best rider of the Masterclass chosen by the YME Racing committee and *bLU cRU* ambassadors will be the 2018 YZ125 *bLU cRU* Cup winner, and will join a Yamaha official EMX125 team as an official rider for the 2019 season.

3. Participation Requirements

- a) The participation in the Cup is restricted to the national championships in Europe.
- b) The rider must be fully licensed in their national federation and racing

- with a Yamaha YZ125 for a championship in an European country;
- c) In order to participate in the Cup, the rider must have been born between 1st January 2002 and 1st January 2005;
- d) It is mandatory for all riders participating in the Cup to use the YZ125 bLU cRU Cup sticker kit provided by YME during their national championship season, Superfinale and Masterclass.

4. Insurance

- a) The insurance for YZ125 bLU cRU Cup is a responsibility of each national federation and, regarding specifically the Superfinale, of FIM/FIM EUROPE;
- b) The indemnity and liability clauses are set by the insurance included in the FIM/FIM EUROPE and national federation licenses;
- c) YME and its branches are excluded from any liability in case of accident that causes any injury, permanent disability or death.

5. Attendance at the events

- a) The riders must be racing in their national championship and are obliged to attend a minimum of 50% of the races in this championship in order to be able to participate in the Superfinale;
- b) YME is responsible for defining the rider allocation per country and selection of riders for the Superfinale;
- c) The total amount of 40 riders will be completed with the following criteria per country group:

Group A. Spain / Italy / France / UK / Germany / The Netherlands – TTL 18 riders:

Group B. Sweden / Norway / Denmark / Finland / Belgium / Austria / Switzerland – TTL 14 riders;

Group C. Greece / Portugal / Bulgaria / Poland / Turkey / Ukraine / Latvia / Estonia – TTL 8 riders;

After registration is completed the specific rider's allocation per country will be defined according to the numbers of registration with the target to offer a similar possibility to challenge the Superfinale inside each Group.

d) The riders who manage to reach the following step in the Cup, are obliged to attend, unless prevented as a result of major force (injury, severe health problem). In this case, the rider will be replaced with a reserve rider.

6. Costs

- a) All the participation costs of this Cup (national championships, Superfinale and Masterclass) will be the rider/ team responsibility, including, but not limited to, transport & logistics, bike purchase and usage, parts, mechanical & assistance, licensing for national championship and Superfinale;
- b) There is no subscription fee for this Cup, including the Superfinale, Masterclass and EMX125 ride (excluding national championship licensing and participation fees defined by the national federation);
- c) YME will provide a cost-free bLU cRU welcome pack (2/T-shirt, 1/Hoody, 1/Umbrella, Cap, Back pack, bLU cRU water bottle) and an exclusive sticker kit for the bike;
- d) In case the rider requires more bike sticker kits, these should be requested to YME, through < bLUcRU@yamaha-racing.com > and these will be provided for a promotional cost via YME Distributors.

7. Registration Instructions

- a) To join the YZ125 bLU cRU Cup, it is mandatory to fill in the complete registration form and send it to < bLUcRU@yamaha-racing.com >;
- b) In order to be considered valid, the form needs to be signed by both the rider and one of the parents or legal tutors;
- c) The rider will then receive a confirmation email from YME and the rider's registration is only confirmed and finalized after this;
- d) All the information provided by the rider must be under his responsibility, as this will be checked by the national distributors.

8. Cancellation of events

For any reason, and without prior notice, YME reserves the right to cancel the event.

9. EMX125 2019 participation conditions

- a) The best rider chosen from the Masterclass will be participating in the EMX125 championship in 2019 for the Yamaha MJC official team;
- b) The rider will be supported by Yamaha as an official rider under the conditions of an to be agreed contract with YME;
- c) The rider participating in the EMX125 championship will have to follow the rules and instructions of YME and the team, including all and any sponsorship agreements.

10. Image rights

Rider shall grant or procure the granting, free of charge, to YME the exclusive right to use rider's name, rider's personal racing number design(s), signature, initials, likeness, including photographed portraits, film, video, CD-rom, CD-I and other footage or comments by electronic means of rider, and comments and opinions, in connection with advertisements.

11. Applicable law

- a) By providing all the data, the rider acknowledges YME the right to use the data for registration purposes under the laws of the Netherlands;
- b) The rider agrees that any disputes in connection with the use of this information or in connection to their participation in the Cup shall be resolved by the competent court of Amsterdam, the Netherlands.
